Special Services



1. Special Pickups

Special Pick Ups are any quantity of material in excess of maximum weekly collections or any materials that are to be collected off the regular scheduled route at the request of the customer, including materials that were missed on the regular scheduled route due to the fault of the customer not having the materials at the curbside at the scheduled pickup time. Upon notification of the existence of a special pick up, the Public Works Department will respond within three working days. Special Pickups will be billed to the customer at \$94.00 per load + tipping fees.

2. Appliances

The Town shall collect white goods such as water heaters, stoves, and refrigerators. The town will not collect any appliance until all the doors of each appliance have been removed as required by state law. Additionally, the Town shall collect brown goods such as chairs, sofas, and beds. These collections are made on the same schedule as household and yard waste pickup.

3. Tire Disposal

The Town will collect tires only off the rim during the regular trash collection schedule. The Town will not collect or handle any tires known to have come from outside the Town limits. Only passenger and light truck tires will be collected. The maximum number of tires per week that the Town will collect for any one location is four (4).

4. Recyclables

Recycling is a free service offered by the Town of Smithfield and by Johnston County. Residents can dispose of their recyclables at the collection site located at the Public Works Garage, 231 Hospital Rd. Residents, at their discretion, can also dispose of their recyclables at various Johnston County container sites located all over the county free of charge and with no county waste decal required.
