SRAC Suggested Rates

We talked last month about the Johnston County School rate. This rate will be added at the beginning of the 2012-2013 Fiscal year. Also there is talk of adding a Johnston Community College rate. All is aimed to increase revenue.

Budget

Last year at this time we were about \$65,000 in the negative. This year we are \$12,000 in the negative, with approximately six months left in the budget year. We expect to be in the positive as we finish this year. This is mostly due to the cost off-set from the generator. Even with fuel & maintenance cost. The generator is expecting to recoup cost after 4-5 years.

Jumpstart Program

We would like to start a Jumpstart Program "preschool".... Expected to bring \$20,000 revenue. Was met with some resistance from Town Council. They were concerned about the affect this would have on other preschools in the area, specifically churches. We have spoken with the churches and they are for it. Most are either full and/or have a waiting list. Both parties agreed that they would not stand in the way because it would directly benefit the children.

Mr. Marrett suggested that we look in to offering Physical Education activities to the Homeschoolers of Johnston County. Kristin Sasser said that when we first opened we created an Art class for Homeschoolers. This class was created based on the Home School curriculm. The class was never held due to the resistance of the Homeschoolers and being a revenue based class.

Johnston County Sports Council

Tim Johnson told everyone that this group has met and is working on bringing together facilities and tournaments.
