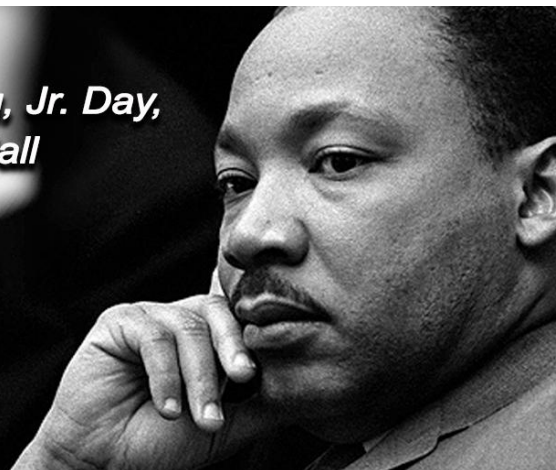

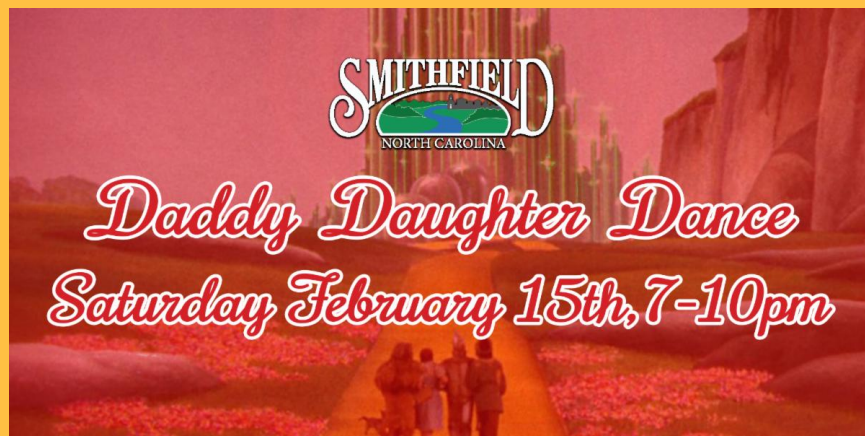

Council Meeting Highlights

January 7, 2020
Regular Meeting Summary:



1. Mayor M. Andy Moore presented at Proclamation to the Carolyn Ennis for her service to the Johnston County and Smithfield Library Board of Trustees.
2. Mayor Moore administered the oath of Office to new volunteer Firefighter Carl Chase Gurley.
3. Stuart Hill representing the audit firm of Thompson, Price, Scott and Adams presented the 2019 audit to the Town Council.
4. Mark Beauchamp of Utility Financial Solutions presented (via teleconference) the results of the Water and Wastewater Fund Financial Projection study.
5. The Town Council denied a rezoning request (RX-19-02) by Brightleaf Development Partners, LLC.
6. The Town Council approved the Consent Agenda.
7. The Town Council adopted Resolution #653 (02-2020 directing the Town Clerk to investigate the noncontiguous annexation request (ANX-19-02) made by Johnston County.
8. The Town Council approved the following Council board appointments: Mayor Pro-Tem Dunn to serve as an alternate on the Triangle J. Council of Government's Board of Delegates; Councilman Rabil to serve on the Stormwater Advisory Committee; Councilman Wood to serve as an ex-officio member of the Public Library of Johnston County and Smithfield Board of Trustees
9. The Town Council approved the bid from Atlantic Cost Fire Trucks in the amount of \$560,500 for the purchase of a 2020 Smeal Fire Engine.
10. The Town Council approved the bid from Performance Doge in the amount of \$162,246 for the purchase of 7 Dodge Chargers for the Police Department.
11. The Town Council tabled discussions on amendments to the salary schedule.
12. The Town Council recessed the meeting until Wednesday, January 15th at 6:30 to discuss Business items 5, 6, and 7.

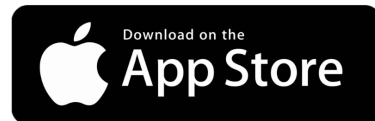
