





## **Council Meeting Highlights**

February 4, 2020

### **Regular Meeting Summary:**



- 1. The Town Council approved a \$500 donation to the Johnston Health Foundation's Heart Fund's "All in Red" Campaign.
- 2. The Town Council adopted Ordinance #502 extending the corporate limits of the Town due to the annexation request made by Johnston County.
- 3. The Town Council approved the rezoning petition made by the Town of Smithfield, RZ-20-01.
- 4. The Town Council approved the Consent Agenda.
- 5. The Town Council approved the purchase of two parcels of land on Highway 210 for future parks.
- 6. The Town Council approved the funding for the replacement of a bridge on the

greenway.

- 7. The Town Council approved a budget amendment for the Electric Department.
- 8. The Town Council authorized Town staff to begin negotiations with the Wooten Company on design services for the Durwood Stephenson water line Phase II.
- 9. The Town Council adopted Ordinance #501. This ordinance addresses dilapidated buildings in the Town of Smithfield.
- 10. The Town Council adopted Ordinance #503. This ordinances addresses commercial tire storage in the Town of Smithfield.
- 11. The Town Council approved the removal of some signs throughout the Town as a part of the Wayfinding Project.
- 12. The Town Council approved the installation of a G2 wayfinding sign on Outlet Center Drive to replace the current welcome sign and investigate the replacement of the welcome sign on North Brightleaf Boulevard.
