Congratulations to the SSS ProStart Culinary Team for winning first place in their competition at Johnson and Wales University in Charlotte last weekend!



There are still several openings available for your children to join us for our Spring Sharks swimming program. Classes begin Tuesday, March 3rd.


This program is open from K-12th grades and is held on Tuesdays and Thursdays through April 30th. Your kids will have so much fun learning stroke techniques and development in the water!
