Council Meeting Highlights

March 3, 2020

Regular Meeting Summary:

- 1. Captain James Grady presented Master Police Officer Sean Cook with the Smithfield Police Department's Officer of the Year for 2019.
- **2.** The Town Council approved the rezoning petition made by True Line Surveying, RZ-20-02.
- 3. The Town Council approved the Consent Agenda.
- **4.** The Town Council approved a request by the Police Department to submit a grant application to the Governors Highway Safety program to create a traffic safety team.
- 5. The Town Council approved the acceptance of Spring Branch Stormwater grant.
- **6.** The Town Council authorized staff to move forward with the Downtown Wi-Fi Project.
- 7. The Town Council approved entering into a contract with the Wooten Company in the amount of \$65,000 for design services for the Durwood Stephenson water line phase II.



8. The Town Council approved changing the name of Booker Dairy Road Extension to M. Durwood Stephenson Parkway and request that NCDOT change the name of M. Durwood Stephenson Highway to M. Durwood Stephenson Parkway.
