The following are measures that have been taken by the Town of Smithfield during the COVID-19 Pandemic. These serve as a reminder if you are needing town services:

--- The Planning Department is closed for face-to-face business until further notice. Those needing assistance may call **(919) 934-2116 ext. 1111 or ext. 1114**. --- You can still make payments at Town Hall but will do so via a speaker placed in our vestibule at the rear of the building. For additional safety, we are only allowing one person at a time in the vestibule. Please maintain appropriate social distancing outside Town Hall as well; lines are in place on the walkway for assistance.

The following payment options are available:

1. Pay online at [www.smithfield-nc.com](http://www.smithfield-nc.com). Click on the "Pay Utility" icon on the homepage.
2. Call 1-855-603-9197 (debit/credit payments only).
3. Place your payment in one of the two drop boxes outside, either the drop box attached to the building OR in the parking lot. If you are paying with CASH, we ask that you please use the drop box attached to the building.

Payments received in either drop box before 5pm will be processed for the date the payment was received.

### **Neuse Charter's Triggs wins NCHSAA "Heart of A Champion" Award**

Congratulations to Neuse Charter student-athlete Tylyia Triggs. She is one of 35 athletes in the state to receive the North Carolina High School Athletic Association "Heart of a Champion" award.

To qualify, student-athletes must have participated in at least one varsity sport or activity, including cheerleading, during the 2019-

2020 school year, have not been ejected from any contest, and must have demonstrated outstanding citizenship and sportsmanship during their high school careers.
