Town of Smithfield Adjustments during COVID-19

The following are measures that have been taken by the Town of Smithfield during the COVID-19 Pandemic. These serve as a reminder if you are needing town services:

--- The Planning Department is closed for face-to-face business until further notice. Those needing assistance may call **(919) 934-2116 ext. 1111 or ext. 1114**. --- You can still make payments at Town Hall but will do so via a speaker placed in our vestibule at the rear of the building. For additional safety, we are only allowing one person at a time in the vestibule. Please maintain appropriate social distancing outside Town Hall as well; lines are in place on the walkway for assistance.

301 Endless Yard Sale Moved to 2021


The decision was made recently to postpone the 301 Endless Yard Sale to next year after discussing the




"Be The Light" Event Held Monday for Student-Athletes

Neuse Charter Recognized As One of NC's Top High Schools


