#### Town of Smithfield Phase Two Plans

Last week, <u>Governor Roy Cooper signed an Executive Order</u> to move into "Phase Two" of reopening North Carolina. **Phase Two continues until June 26th at 5pm**.

Under Phase Two, restaurants, salons, barber shops, camps and public pools are open but with limited on capacity and cleaning requirements. Businesses that remain closed are playgrounds, nightclubs, gyms and indoor fitness centers and entertainment venues.

The following measures are in place for the Town of Smithfield:

--- The Planning Department is closed for face-to-face business until further notice. Those needing assistance may call **(919) 934-2116 ext. 1111 or ext. 1114**. --- You can still make payments at Town Hall but will do so via a speaker placed in our vestibule at the rear of the building. For additional safety, we are only allowing one person at a time in the vestibule. Please maintain appropriate social distancing outside Town Hall as well; lines are in place on the walkway for assistance.

The following payment options are available:

- 2. Call 1-855-603-9197 (debit/credit payments only).
- 3. Place your payment in one of the two drop boxes outside, either the drop box attached to the building OR in the parking lot. If you are paying with CASH, we ask that you please use the drop box attached to the building.

Payments received in either drop box before 5pm will be processed for the date the payment was received.

- Date Of Service

### Smithfield Parks and Recreation Announces Reopen Plans, Beginning June 1st

In response to Governor Cooper's Phase Two plans, Smithfield Parks and Recreation has announced the following measures:

Athletic fields and shelters will be open for rentals **beginning June 1st**. Athletic fields will be open for **practice only**. Reservations can be made, beginning **TODAY (May 28th)**, by phone (919-934-2148) during normal business hours. Per Executive Order 141, social distancing must be maintained and gatherings are limited to 25 persons.

The Smithfield Recreation and Aquatic Center will open the pool to **members** for lap swimming only **beginning June 1<sup>st</sup>**. Reservations can be made, in one hour increments, for the following times:


Monday through Friday: 5:30am-9:30am, 2:00pm-6:00pm




Have You Completed the 2020 Census?
