Town of Smithfield Phase Two Operational Procedures

Phase Two continues until June 26th at 5pm.

Under Phase Two, restaurants, salons, barber shops, camps and public pools are open but with limited on capacity and cleaning requirements. Businesses that remain closed are playgrounds, nightclubs, gyms and indoor fitness centers and entertainment venues.

The following measures are in place for the Town of Smithfield:

--- The Planning Department is closed for face-to-face business until further notice. Those needing assistance may call **(919) 934-2116 ext. 1111 or ext. 1114**. --- You can still make payments at Town Hall but will do so via a speaker placed in our vestibule at the rear of the building. For additional safety, we are only allowing one person at a time inside the vestibule. Please maintain appropriate social distancing outside Town Hall as well; lines are in place on the walkway for assistance.

The following payment options are available:

2. Call 1-855-603-9197 (debit/credit payments only).
3. Place your payment in one of the two drop boxes outside, either the drop box attached to the building OR in the parking lot. If you are paying with CASH, we ask that you please use the drop box attached to the building.

Payments received in either drop box before 5pm will be processed for the date the payment was received.

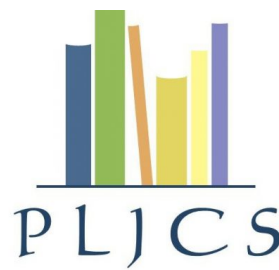
The pool at the SRAC is open to members for lap swimming only. Reservations can be made, in one hour increments, for the following times:

Public Library of Johnston County and Smithfield Reopens



The Public Library of Johnston County and Smithfield is open! For the safety and well-being of everyone, the library will allow a maximum of fifty people at a time in the facility. The library has hand sanitizer stations throughout the building to prevent the spread of COVID-19. The staff will wear face masks and new shields are in place at customers' service desks. Other restrictions and safety guidelines:

- Patrons will be allowed to browse the shelves and check out materials.
- Patrons will not have access to any meeting room spaces.
- Printers will be self-service.
- The library is quarantining and disinfecting all returned materials for a minimum of 24 hours.
- No fines will be assessed on the materials.
- The library will allow patrons to use computers by appointment only; please make sure you call and set an appointment before coming to the library.

At the end of the month, the library will reevaluate and could amend some of these measures.

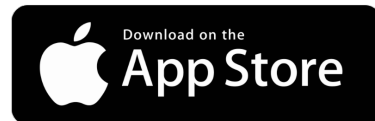
