Governor Extends "Phase Two" Across State Until July 17th, Issues Face Covering Mandate

On Wednesday afternoon, Governor Roy Cooper extended "Phase Two" of the COVID-19 restrictions until July 17th at 5pm. Additionally, Cooper added a face covering mandate, requiring the use of face coverings in retail businesses, restaurants (when customers are not at their table), personal care and grooming businesses, child care facilities, long-term care facilities and more.

The following measures remain in place for the Town of Smithfield:

--- You can still make payments at Town Hall but will do so via a speaker placed in our vestibule at the rear of the building. For additional safety, we are only allowing one person at a time inside the vestibule. Please maintain appropriate social distancing outside Town Hall as well; lines are in place on the walkway for assistance.

The following payment options are available:

- 2. Call 1-855-603-9197 (debit/credit payments only).
- 3. Place your payment in one of the two drop boxes outside, either the drop box attached to the building OR in the parking lot. If you are paying with CASH, we ask that you please use the drop box attached to the building.

Payments received in either drop box before 5pm will be processed for the date the payment was received.

The Town of Smithfield Sanitation Department schedule for Saturday, July 4th will be as follows:

Household waste and yard debris collections for Friday, July 3rd will be collected on Wednesday, July 1st. All other customers will have their household waste and yard

debris collected on their regular scheduled day. Please have your curbside container and or all debris at curbside after 5:00pm on the day before your collection day. All curbside containers must be removed from curbside no later than 8:00am on the day after collection.

The Convenience Center for recycling will be closed on Saturday, July 4th.





Smithfield Parks and Recreation Reopening Reminders

Athletic fields and shelters are open for rentals. Athletic fields will be open for **practice only**. Reservations can be made by phone **(919-934-2148)** during normal business hours. Per Executive Order 141, social distancing must be maintained and gatherings are limited to 25 persons.

The pool at the SRAC is open to members for lap swimming only. Reservations can be made, in one hour increments, for the following times:

Monday through Friday: 5:30am-9:30am, 2:00pm-6:00pm

Saturday: 8:00am-12:00pm

Basketball courts, playgrounds and restrooms remain closed; tennis courts remain open.


