


Upcoming COVID-19 Testing

Smithfield-Selma High School is currently hosting COVID-19 testing EVERY TUESDAY from 9am-11am. There is no cost for the testing; bring our ID and insurance card with you.

In addition, the Smithfield Progressive Men's Club, located at 1208 Old Goldsboro Road, will host COVID-19 testing on the following days and times:

TODAY - Thursday, November 12 (9am-1pm) Saturday, November 14 (10am-2pm) Monday, November 16 (9am-1pm) Wednesday, November 18 (3pm-7pm) Saturday, November 21 (10am-2pm)



The testing is free and, although walk-ups are accepted, we encourage residents to register and schedule an appointment. Call 877-562-4850 or register online: https://lhi.care/covidtesting.


