New Convenience Center Hours As of June 1st

In an effort to reduce congestion and traffic around the construction of the water plant expansion, the Town of Smithfield Convenience Center, located on 231 Hospital Rd., will be changing its hours of operation.

Effective June 1st, the convenience center will be open Wednesdays from 7am-4pm and Saturdays from 8am-12pm.

All users must live inside Smithfield town limits to gain access to the dumpsters or the yard waste pit; a valid ID and a copy of your utility bill with an active account number will be required.

Those who live in Smithfield, but not in the town limits, can dispose of any yard waste, debris and recyclables at the Johnston County landfill or one of its convenience sites throughout the county.

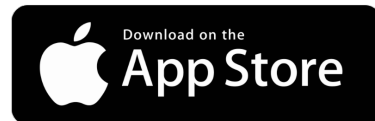
