Smithfield's 2021 4th of July Fireworks Display will be held at 9:00 p.m. this Sunday, July 4th, at Johnston Community College. JCC parking lots will open for viewing only (no restrooms available) beginning at 8:00 p.m., and the fireworks display is set to begin at 9:00 p.m. in the field across from campus.

In order to ensure the safety of attendees, College Road will be closed from Market Street to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard from 8:45 p.m. until approximately 9:30 p.m.

"Although this year's fireworks display will be different from the celebration that we typically have downtown, we are glad to be able to celebrate in a way that is safe for our community, and hope that our 2022 Independence Celebration can take place once again in the heart of Downtown Smithfield."


Tennis, wrestling, basketball and an Artsy Kids Camp are coming to the Smithfield Recreation and Aquatics Center this month.

The camp is led by James Reid.


