Smithfield Public Utilities Performing Routine Maintenance on Flowers St. Water Tank

Every two to three years, the Town of Smithfield Public Utilities Department performs routine maintenance on each of our water tanks. The maintenance involves emptying each tank, general inspection of the tank, cleaning, painting and, finally, refilling the tanks. Our employees are currently working through these necessary steps at the Flowers St. water tank in West Smithfield.

During this time, customers could experience intermittent low water pressure. These small pressure drops are normal and a direct result of the maintenance of the water tanks. The work on the Flowers St. water tank should be completed by October 15th.

The Spartans are on a bye week this week but return to action next Friday night (September 17th) at Tucker Stadium to face cross-county rival South Johnston.


Game time is 7pm and tickets can be purchased online at *ticketspicket.com*.

Johnston County Public Schools Announces Day 10 Attendance

The total attendance for Johnston County Schools on Friday, September 3rd was 37,593 students.

The 10th day of school is a key number in determining state funding for the 2021-2022 school year. That number is up 782 from last year's total, which saw 36,811 students pass through school doors on the tenth day of classes.

The Town of Smithfield is proud to partner with Johnston County Government to offer both COVID-19 vaccination and testing sites in Smithfield.

The Johnston County Public Health Department offers the vaccine at 517 N. Brightleaf Blvd. weekdays from 9am-4pm and Tuesdays from 9am-6pm. Walk-ins are welcome or you can make an appointment online at *takemyshot.nc.gov*.

COVID-19 testing is offered every Monday through Saturday from 11am-7pm at the Smithfield Progressive Men's Club, located at 1208 Old Goldsboro Road.


Smithfield Town Board Opportunities:
