StrEATery on July 15th from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

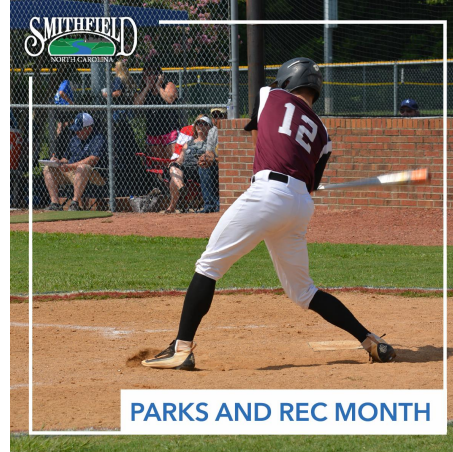

The Johnston County Heritage Center will be closed to the public during the week of July 11-16 while staff and volunteers relocate the Center's Reading Room from the third floor to the ground floor.

"We are excited to be able to provide easier access to our genealogy and local history collections," said Heritage Center Director Todd Johnson. "This move also frees up space on our upper floors so we can continue growing our collection."

A new County history museum, slated to open in Smithfield the fall, is in the process of being set up at 329 E. Market Street. The museum will include a gift shop and over 4,000 square feet of exhibition space.
